To help you, here's a useful guide about what can be recycled in our coloured bins:



## BLUE BIN

Cereal boxes | Cardboard packaging and egg boxes | Telephone directories  
Junk mail | Letters and waste paper  
Newspapers and magazines



## BROWN BIN

Food and drink cans | Glass bottles and jars  
Plastic bottles, including bleach, shampoo, hand wash and shower gel bottles



## GREEN BIN

Small twigs and branches  
Leaves and grass  
Cut flowers



## PLEASE NOTE

All bins should be positioned at the kerbside before 6am on collection day. No additional bags of rubbish can be left with grey bins. Additional bags of recycling can be left out with blue and brown bins.

If you're using a private company to collect your unwanted items and rubbish ALWAYS ask to see their waste carrier's licence. Make sure you get a waste transfer note so you know where your waste will be disposed of. A valid waste carriers licence doesn't always mean that your waste will be disposed of properly. If your waste is fly tipped you could be prosecuted and fined.

If you're looking to get rid of unwanted items, why not visit one of our household waste recycling centres, donate them to charity, or use our large item collection service.
